
- Press EPG to launch EPG Feature



Create a favorite channels list

- 1. To set Favorite channel list for TV
 - Select "Main Menu" and go to Edit Channel
 - Highlight a channel you want to include on your Favorite Channels list, press OK
- Repeat this step for all channels you want to include on your list
- 2. To set Favorite channel list for Radio
 - Select "Main Menu" and go to Edit Channel

- Repeat this step for all channels you want to include on your list
- 3. Favorite list will also be invoked if the hot key 'Fav' is pressed.

Channel Tuning: Manual / Quick Search
